## Join the Community Liaison Committee

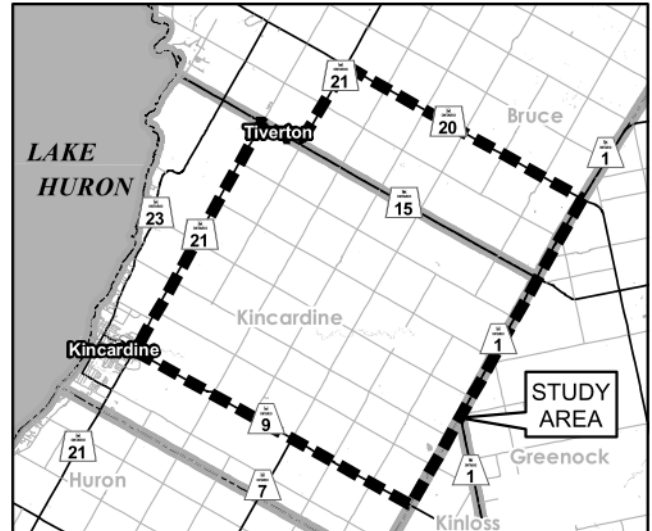


### About the Project

The Armow Wind Project is an approximately 180 megawatt commercial wind energy generation facility located in the Municipality of Kincardine, Bruce County, Ontario. The Armow Wind Project is expected to generate enough clean energy to power 55,000 homes. The Project is being developed by SP Armow Wind Ontario LP by its general partner SP Armow Wind Ontario GP Inc. (SP Armow), which obtained approval from the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) to build a Class 4 Wind facility in October 2013.

### Get Involved

Good planning includes the involvement of the community as a key partner. SP Armow is establishing a Community Liaison Committee (CLC) to discuss the important aspects of construction, installation, use, operation, maintenance and retirement of the Armow Wind Project. This committee is a requirement of SP Armow's Renewable Energy Approval (REA) and will serve as a forum to share ideas, express concerns and to provide the community with ongoing updates about the Project. An independent, third-party facilitator from AECOM has been retained to facilitate the Armow Wind Project Community Liaison Committee meetings.

### Participate in the Discussion

The Committee for the Armow Wind Project is expected to consist of up to 14 people with membership drawn from a cross-section of the community in order to provide a broad and balanced perspective. Individuals from the following groups are intended to represent this Committee:

- Landowners;
- Residents within 1 km of the Project;
- Aboriginal communities;
- Members of the agriculture community;
- Business / industry representatives;
- Local social and environment organizations; and,
- Representatives from local government agencies.

Each Committee meeting will be open to the public so that the community can participate by observing. Requests for delegations are welcomed and can be made prior to each meeting to the committee facilitator.

The Armow Wind Project CLC is expected to meet at least four times over a two year period, with two meetings each year. We expect to hold our first CLC meeting in the first week of February, 2014. The CLC meetings will be held at a time and location that is convenient to most members. Committee members will be encouraged to share any information the results of all CLC discussions with other interested community members.
