### **Community Liaison Committee (CLC) Member Application Form**

The Armow Wind Project is a commercial wind energy generation facility located in the Municipality of Kincardine, Bruce County, Ontario. The project will produce approximately 180 megawatts of power and is being developed by SP Armow Wind Ontario LP by its general partner SP Armow Wind Ontario GP Inc. (SP Armow). In October 2013, SP Armow obtained approval from the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) to build a Class 4 Wind facility.

Good planning includes the involvement of the community as a key partner. SP Armow is establishing a Community Liaison Committee to act as an advisory body and discuss the important aspects of construction, installation, use, operation, maintenance and retirement of the Armow Wind Project. This Committee is a requirement of the Armow Wind Project Renewable Energy Approval (REA) and will serve as a forum to share ideas, express concerns and to provide the community with ongoing updates about the Project.

An independent, third-party facilitator from AECOM has been retained to chair the Community Liaison Committee meetings. The committee will not be revisiting items associated with the previous MOE approval process.

To ensure that the CLC is effective and embodies the wide range of community interests, the CLC is intended to consist of up to 14 citizens from the following groups:

- Landowners;
- Residents within 1 km of the Project;
- Aboriginal communities;
- Members of the Agriculture community;
- Business / industry representatives;
- Local social and environment organizations; and,
- Representatives from local government agencies.

The CLC is expected to meet at least four times over a two year period, with two meetings each year. The meetings will be held at a time and location that is convenient to most members. We expect to hold our first meeting in early February 2014.

We will consider the following when confirming the CLC membership:

- Knowledge of the community and the issues / concerns / benefits related to wind energy;
- Leadership in / or commitment to the community;
- Ability to effectively address issues and concerns from a variety of perspectives;
- Ability to respectfully participate in community related and consensus-based discussions;
- Interest in working productively to enable two-way communication between SP Armow and the community; and,
- Ability to work well in a team or on a committee.

Note: Members of the CLC will be chosen by AECOM. For those who express interest but do not become a part of the CLC, all meetings will be open so that the public can attend and observe the conversation. Requests for delegations will be considered in consultation with the CLC and SP Armow. A total of three (3) brief (up to 10 minutes) delegations may be made at each CLC meeting.
